

Curriculum-based assessments (CBA)

CBAs are typically designed by educators to gather information about a student's performance in a specific curriculum (McLoughlin & Lewis, 2005)...(and) to develop instructional plans for a specific student. To gather (these) data...an educator might use task analyses, work sample analyses, portfolio assessments, and/or criterion-referenced tests" (Test, Aspel, & Everson, 2006, pp. 78).
